**Dear Parents/Carers,**

This letter is to inform you of changes to our learning program.

As advised by the Minister for Education and following public health advice, all preschools and schools **will remain open:**

- In Week 10, it is assumed that all children are attending school. Some families have elected to keep their children home and supervise them instead of sending them to school. That is fine and work should have been sent home for them in a 'hard-copy' bundle. This work is expected to be completed by the due date, as it is a 'normal school week'.
- In Week 11 schools have been given four 'Student Free Days' for staff to set up 'learning' at home and 'learning on site' programs ready for next term. No students will be at school for week 11. Subsequently children will be **at home**, under parent supervision.

To support us with our planning for Term 2 we will be contacting all families via a phone call over the next day or two to determine if your child will be attending school, or if they will be learning from home in Term 2. Please forgive us if you have already passed this information on in some form or other previously but we need to 'officially ask and record' your response for our records. Thank you all for your cooperation.

We will also be asking families who have chosen to keep their child home if they have access to the internet and a computer/iPad/tablet. This will help us determine if your child can access online learning materials or will require a learning pack to be sent home. Students attending school will be set up to also learn online to enable us to maintain social distancing requirements.

Please be assured that continuity of learning for all children, whether they be at school or home, and the wellbeing of our children and staff will be our highest priority.
