Dear Parents / Caregivers,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents for their co-operation whilst we have been under restrictions due to Covid-19.

Unfortunately, we still cannot allow site access to anyone other than maintenance, or essential workers at this stage. Parents are invited, as always, to drop their children and pick them up from our front foyer area.

It is very pleasing to note our attendance rate is currently sitting at 91% for Term 2. This is a great achievement and strong indication our school community has faith in how we are dealing with the current crisis. As always, we take our advice from Department for Education and SA Health.

As we move into the post-virus phase and restrictions begin to ease we urge each and every one of you to still practice social distancing and effective personal hygiene practices.

We are envisaging re-opening some of our services, such as the school/community library, in the near future. When we get the go-ahead it will, of course, still be with strict social distancing and personal hygiene requirements. Initially there will be limits on the number of people that can access the site at any one time and there will also be time-limits on borrowing opportunities. Our head-librarian, Carol Strawbridge, will manage the library during its re-opening and she will carefully monitor all government requirements and suggestions. I respectfully request that you listen and cooperate with Carol as she will have a hard enough job to do on behalf of the school and the wider community.

Carol is easy to get along with, but she will be the 'voice of experience' and the school and government representative whilst the library remains under any form of restriction.
